PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW NOTIFICATION

January 2023

Dear Families:

In accordance with ESEA Section 111(h)(6) *PARENTS RIGHT TO-KNOW*, Roselle District 12 is notifying every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right and may request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. This information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teachers includes, at a minimum, the following:

- 1. Whether the teacher has met State qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- 2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency, or the provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- 3. The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- 4. Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

If at any time your child has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher not highly qualified, the school will notify you.
