Math is an exciting subject, and we look forward to embarking on a new math learning journey with you next school year. Math can be a challenging subject at times, but we are confident that if you work hard and seek help when needed, you will be successful.

As you prepare for seventh grade and to help you review standards from this past year's math instruction, we are recommending that you complete a number of selected Khan Academy lessons, which will be assigned to you directly in Khan Academy. These lessons will support your review of how to solve problems using essential math skills and concepts. It is our recommendation that you complete one (1) lesson each week throughout the summer. This includes all Khan Academy lesson subcomponents, such as videos, articles and practice problems.

The assigned Khan Academy lessons focus on the skills that will help you be successful in 7th grade. You will take a pre-assessment during the second week of school on the following skills:

1. Find equivalent ratios
2. Add, subtract, & multiply with fractions and decimals
3. Solve one-step equations
4. Find area and perimeter of polygons
5. Calculate mean, median, mode, and range

The benefits of completing these lessons over the summer include:

- Keeping up your math skills, which will better enable you to smoothly transition to 7th grade math
- Allowing you to show us what you know
- Highlighting math areas where you may need additional support when you start 7th grade

Please try to complete all the assigned Khan Academy lessons by **Tuesday, August 17, 2021**.
