Weekly DuPage County COVID-19 Metrics for Schools

This week we DuPage County has moved to the substantial level of transmission. This is due to the metric for the number of cases per 100,00 people. In Roselle, our newest cases were in the adult age range. **Important Note: The metrics are always for the week prior to posting.** For now, we are continuing with in-person instruction. We will continue to monitor closely, and we will continue to speak with the DuPage County Health Department twice weekly.

At the end of eight weeks of school, we have had 4 cases of COVID-19.
