During Tuesday's Board of Education meeting, I presented to the board and community the latest guidance and directives regarding the opening of school. The role of the Board of Education is to govern the school district and oversee its one employee, the superintendent. The superintendent is charged with the responsibility of all decisions related to the operations of our schools and district. As such, the board reinforced at Tuesday's meeting that the operational decisions for the opening of school will be made by the superintendent and administrative team. I frequently engage in dialogue with individual board members as well as the board as a whole in open meeting formats and will continue to do so.

Since our planning for the 2020-21 school year began last summer, we have worked closely with our Return to Learn team comprised of approximately 20 D12 staff members. They provide insight and suggestions for the implementation of guidance and directives.
