PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Roselle Planning & Zoning Commission will hold Public Hearing PZ 25-1138 on Tuesday, August 5, 2025. The Planning & Zoning Commission will meet at 7:00 pm at the Roselle Village Hall, 31 S. Prospect Street, Roselle, Illinois to consider the petition of Insite Inc. on behalf of the Roselle Park District for a special use permit for a wireless cellular tower in the R-1 Zoning District.

The subject property is commonly known as 400 S. Prospect St., Roselle, IL 60172. PIN: 02-10-250-029. The property is generally located on the northwest corner of E. Walnut St. and S. Prospect St. and known as Kemmerling Park. The subject property is approximately 8.13 acres (354,144 square feet) and is zoned R-1 Single-Family Residence District.

At the public hearing, anyone wishing to make a public statement will be encouraged to do so.
