Anyone wishing to make a public comment must attend in person. Public comments are held at the beginning of the agenda. When you arrive for the meeting, you will be asked to sign in and indicate that you wish to make a comment. The board secretary will call your name, you'll come to the podium at the

front of the room, and you will have two minutes to speak. The board and/or administrative team do not answer questions raised during public comment or engage in conversation with those making comment. All comments are referred to my office, and the appropriate person will respond.

The agenda for a school board meeting is posted the Friday before a meeting on our district website in the Board of Education section. We will be discussing the opening of school tomorrow night. Please note that no action will be taken, including a decision about masks.

Please note that if you are not vaccinated, you are expected to wear a mask at school board meetings.
