## AO Summer Hours

**Meet and Greet at our Schools.**

One of the first events that take place in a new school year is our Meet and Greet at both schools. This is held the afternoon on the day before school begins (Tuesday, August 13, 2024). During this one-hour event, parents/guardians and learners are able to come into the school, bring their supplies to their classroom or locker and meet their teacher for the upcoming year. We encourage families to participate in this event as it helps with those "first day jitters," for both learners and parents.

### Curriculum Night at our Schools

Another important event at the beginning of the year is our Curriculum Night. This is a parents-only event in the evening. Parents have the opportunity to spend time with their learners' teachers to learn more about them, learn about the curriculum and plan for the upcoming school year in the classroom.
