Dear Roselle D12 Families,

We continue to settle into our school year routines as we come to the end of our fourth week of school. This week our grade level teams reviewed start of year assessment data in order to identify students who may require additional academic interventions to support their learning. Parents will receive additional information with specific details if their child will be placed in an intervention. Typically interventions take place during each grade level's WIN (What I Need) time but could also take place at different times throughout the school day based on the child's needs.

COVID-19 Metrics and Information

While we remain hopeful with the news that last week's metrics improved slightly, we remain in the high level of transmission in the community. Our next meeting with the DuPage County Health Department will take place on Monday, September 13.

We currently have had five positive cases of COVID-19 in the district. We are not seeing positive cases as a result of school exposure/spread.

Supporting Students During Periods of Quarantine or Isolation

As a reminder to all families, students invited to join their classes remotely are for COVID-19 quarantine or isolation purposes only. If your child has to miss a day of school for a non-COVID illness or parent excusal absence, we will support their catch up when they return.
