



TRUTH IN TAXATION LAW

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE OF FINAL LEVY

As the undersigned, President of the Board of Education of Roselle School District 12, DuPage County, Illinois, I hereby certify that I am President and presiding officer of the Board of Education of Roselle School District 12, DuPage County, Illinois, and, as such presiding officer, I certify that the tax levy, a copy of which is appended hereto, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects compliant with, the applicable provisions of Sections 18-60 through 18-85 of the *Truth in Taxation Law* (35 ILCS 200/18-55 et seq.), and that:

1. The notice and hearing requirements of Sections 18-70, 18-75 and 18-80 required for an estimated aggregate levy exceeding the prior year's aggregate levy extensions, including abatements prior to extensions, by more than 105% were ***applicable***.
2. The notice and hearing requirements of Section 18-72 required for intent to amend the Board's certificate of tax levy were ***inapplicable***.
3. The notice requirement of Section 18-85 required for a final aggregate levy adopted in excess of the estimated levy were ***inapplicable***.

TRUTH IN TAXATION LAW RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Education of Roselle School District 12, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Board hereby determines that the proposed aggregate levy, exclusive of election costs and levies for debt services and certain leases, estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the year 2022 upon the taxable property in the District is \$10,681,587.


Section 2: That the amount of property taxes, exclusive of election costs and levies for debt service and certain leases, extended on behalf of the District for the year 2021 was \$9,936,542.83.

Section 3: That the foregoing proposed estimated aggregate levy for the year 2022 is equal to 7.5 percent of the foregoing taxes extended for the preceding year, 2021.

Section 4: That the Secretary of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to publish or cause to be published a legal notice of public hearing, in the form of **EXHIBIT A** attached hereto, in accordance with the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
